



2017 UK DATES AND FEES INFORMATION

Note:

- The Registration Fee is £65 and only payable with the student's first course.
 Students can start any Monday on most courses.
- There is a fee for issuing a Confirmation of Acceptance for Studies (CAS), of £60.
- Students will be required to purchase a textbook on arrival. Approximate cost per text book is £30.
- Minimum age for students in adult international classes is 16 years old.
- Daily 2 hour courses (Richmond only) = 9 hours and 10 minutes classroom teaching per week
- Daily 3 hour courses = 13 hours and 45 minutes classroom teaching per week
- Daily 4 hour courses = 18 hours and 45 minutes classroom teaching per week
- Daily 5 hour courses (Richmond only) = 22 hours and 55 minutes classroom teaching per week
- Daily 6 hour courses = 27 hours and 30 minutes classroom teaching per week
- Weekly 6 hour courses = 5 hours and 30 minutes classroom teaching per week
- Daily 3 hour courses + weekly 6 hour courses = 19 hours and 15 minutes classroom teaching per week

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Terms & Conditions

- The course fees and deposit are valid only for the person, course[s] and dates specified on the Enrolment Form.
- 2. The Registration Fee is non-refundable.
- 3. If you cancel your course before arrival due to visa refusal or you are refused entry to the UK, we shall refund your tuition fees in full minus a £65 cancellation charge and the £65 registration fee. You must apply for a refund within six months of the refusal date. If you cancel your course before arrival for any other reason, no refund or credit will be given. (note: special cancellation terms apply to Erasmus+ grant applicants). If you cancel your course after arrival, leave it early, or miss any lessons, no refund or credit will be given, including in case of sickness.
- 4. The minimum age for all English language classes and programmes is 16.
- 5. All 3 hour classes include a 15 minute break.
- All 2 hour classes include a 10 minute break.
- General Student Visa (GSV) students are required to attend an additional 1 ¼ hours per week.
- 8. One-to-One lessons include a 10 minute break if more than one hour is taken at a time
- When necessary, the College reserves the right to alter the timetable and/or transfer students from one class or course to another, from one time of study to another, and to merge small classes or cancel classes and courses. Fees may also be subject to change.
- 10. If you are a complete Beginner in English we may not have a suitable class for you.
- 11. There is no reduction in fees where there is a U.K. public holiday (see below).
- You are strongly advised to organize medical and cancellation/ curtailment insurance before you travel.
- 13. Holidays can be taken by arrangement but we require at least 2 weeks' notice.
- 14. You cannot change from a full-time course to a part-time course or One-to-One class.
- 15. OHC's policy to provide a safe environment for staff and students free from violence, abuse and discrimination of any kind. The school has a zero tolerance policy towards bullying, verbal or physical violence and drug taking. If your behaviour contradicts this, we reserve the right to remove you from the school without any compensation.
- Oxford House College may use additional classrooms in other buildings located near to the College, including local colleges/ universities.
- 17. In arranging accommodation, Oxford House College uses agencies for the placement of students.
