

WHICH COURSE?

Know your level, understand your targets, choose the appropriate course and pick a location. It's as simple as that!

WHAT IS MY CURRENT LEVEL?

We teach up to 7 different levels in our schools, based on the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR). In order to learn effectively, it ? is important that you study at the correct level, with students of similar ability. The table below shows the different levels of classes at our schools, indicating the communicative skills you will have when you complete each level.

The progress you will make with us depends on a number of things. We expect most students to progress to the next level after 12 weeks, if studying 15 hours per week. This time may be longer

or shorter, depending on many factors. The key to progress is to practice English outside the classroom; with other students on the social programme, with your host family or through doing homework.

When you arrive at the school you will be given a placement test and we will discuss your individual priorities, strengths and weaknesses, in order to find the best class for you. You will have regular tutorials and progress tests during your course to make sure you are making the most of your time with us.

OUR COURSES

Every student has different goals when it comes to learning English. We offer a wide range of course options to suit all needs and ensure success.

General English classes

These classes work on the four skills (reading, speaking, listening and writing) and have a strong grammar and vocabulary input appropriate to the level of the class. The focus is on the presentation of new language, and using the communicative teaching approach, to enable the student to practise in realworld situations. The course books that are used are mapped to the **CEFR framework and** ALTE Can-Do statements.

These classes also have **bi-weekly progress** tests, which review learning from the previous two weeks, as well as individual student tutorials, in which the student and teacher discuss the student's individual learning needs.

Skills classes

These classes promote competency in the **four** skills (reading, speaking, listening and writing) as well as having a focus on pronunciation. Each week has a dedicated topic, drawn from the materials set aside for these classes. The content is also drawn from student requests and needs identified by the teacher. These classes are designed to enable the student to use what they have learnt in class or in their daily lives.

Exam classes

These classes focus on language and skills required for each specific exam, as laid out by the accrediting bodies and course books written for the exam in question. There is also a focus on exam task awareness and the development of strategies to cope with the exam, plus timed practice under exam conditions. Class content is focussed on the requirements of the exam being taken.

One to One lessons

These focus on the **specific requirements** of the student. For example, if the student plans to go to university, the One to One classes could focus on academic English skills and development of strategies for writing and reading. If the student needs English for their job, we can help identify specific language requirements, and devise a programme to focus on meeting those particular language needs

Self Study

All students have access to the school's online learning platform. You can choose from a number of self-study exercises; Entry test feedback: First you do an entry test. You can see the results immediately, and you will be directed to different exercises which focus on the mistakes you made in the test.

Genuine reading texts: These are authentic reading texts from recognised news websites (e.g. BBC). The tests all have vocabulary lists and vocabulary tests. Study plan lessons: These have materials relating to a wide variety of topics. You skills and practise vocabulary in relevant

External Links: These link to a variety of different study support pages (e.g. British

We have educational strategies in place to ensure that each student progresses well and reaches their full potential.

Extra Language Practice

Student Support offers extra language practice and input to students who feel they would like extra help in a certain area. Student Support is a 15 minute 1-to-1 session or sometimes a drop-in session, overseen by our most experienced teachers.

Online Platform

Using our online platform, students can request **specific help**, for instance: "how can I construct better sentences?", or "How can I write more cohesive IELTS style essays?" This service, while available to all our students, is especially useful for students who are finding one specific skill, for example writing, particularly difficult to improve.

For Cambridge exam students who want extra exam practice and feedback, particularly with speaking, it is possible to book sessions in student support.

The Lanes offer students a vintage shopping experience, while main attractions include the Royal Pavilion, Brighton Marina and the recently opened i360 observation tower.









The safety and well being of all our students is our primary concern, and is something we take very seriously. Junior and adult students study in the same school, but are placed in separate classes. We are passionate about creating a school life that enables every student to flourish. For us, a school is not just about teaching and learning. We also need to attend to the well being of our students.

Our Staff

Our staff are accustomed to helping people from different backgrounds and cultures and are experienced in dealing with a wide range of personal or study related issues.

Risk Assessments

Our activity and excursion programmes are very carefully organised and planned. Student safety is of the utmost importance. We ensure this by carrying out detailed and regular risk assessments of all our activities and excursions, wherever they are held.

We take extensive measures to ensure the safety and well-being of juniors after their arrival and throughout their course;

- Dedicated safeguarding officer in each school
- Named staff who students can speak to if they have any problems
- Personalised student ID card provided on arrival, which contains the school's 24-hour emergency telephone number
- Students aged under 18 who are not members of study groups are asked to sign in each day when they arrive at school
- Curfew times for host family accommodation
- Social programme activities are always supervised by a member of our staff
- Emergency next of kin contact details are are kept with the 24-hour emergancy phone - so that we can always reach parents in case of urgency
- All students receive a detailed induction, during which we explain
 UK laws and rules which are relevant to their age group, give advice on personal, road and transport safety

Arrival

We recommend that all junior students (aged under 18) should be met at their point of arrival by a member of staff. Groups are met by a staff member and taken to their accommodation. Appropriate information is given to group leaders and students when they arrive, in addition to the induction they receive on their first day at the school. All students have a 24/7 phone contact, and if appropriate, id cards.

Medical And General Insurance

In Britain, free medical treatment is available through the National Health Service to all EU students and students from countries with reciprocal health agreements. Students who are not covered by the National Health Service are advised to take out medical insurance before leaving their home countries. We strongly advise students to take out individual personal insurance to cover personal belongings, etc, before they come to the UK. In addition, in case of any medical matters arising, all centres have staff members trained in First Aid, and all centres have first-aid kits on site, as well as close links with local doctors, dentists and hospitals.
