

Your Lessons

On a St Juniors Junior Summer course, students will receive 20 English lessons a week. The lessons are designed to focus on building their communication skills and confidence in using English. Lessons will also include preparation for excursions and activities, to help them continue their learning outside of the classroom.

TEACHERS

Our friendly and professional teachers use communicative methods in a tightknit learning environment to help students learn quickly. All our teachers are qualified English language teachers in order to ensure a high-quality level of teaching. The course focuses on all four skills but mainly speaking. Our teachers will help students leave our course feeling more confident, able to speak to an audience and with a wider range of vocabulary and functional language.

THEME OF THE WEEK

Lessons and the social programme are based around a theme of the week. This theme allows students to learn useful language and skills, which they can then use in their end of week project. Students present their projects at the end of each week, which can be anything ranging from a presentation, a film, a town they have designed and much more. The projects allow them to work with their fellow students, from a whole range of nationalities, and practice a variety of skills. Example themes include Food, Media and Fame, and the Environment.

WORKBOOKS

During their stay, students create a workbook that stands as a portfolio of their work to take home. It includes aims of the week, their targets reached, work based on their excursions and records of language learned.

REPORTS

At the end of their stay, students make graduation hats and enjoy a small personalised graduation celebration. They receive a certificate showing their level and length of stay, plus a full report written by their teacher.

We offer a wide range of English Plus sport and language options, which take place over 5 hours per week in the afternoons and enable students to tailor their Junior Summer Course to their specific interests and needs.

LANGUAGE OPTIONS

Students can personalise their course on arrival by adding one of our English Plus language options, available at most centres in the UK, USA and Canada at **no extra cost.**

Specialised Courses

On our specialised courses, young learners can learn English whilst trying something new and developing skills for future careers. Students also have the chance to explore the UK or USA and have fun on our general English social programme.

Each course, which runs for three weeks, includes 20 specialised lessons a week, accommodation, meals and the rest of our Juniors package. Students will enjoy meals and some activities with the general programme students, along with some alternative activities and excursions related to their studies.

ENGLISH FOR CODING

This is the perfect course for children and teenagers who love technology or video games and who aspire to work in coding. Students learn English through creating projects such as websites, games and apps within a class of likeminded learners.

The course will help students:

- Improve their basic coding and computer programming skills through building online platforms and games
- Through group work and an online platform build either a website and app or a game
- Learn specialised coding vocabulary and terms
- Explore coding as a future career
- Learn functional language such as language for meetings, giving opinions, problem solving and presenting

Students on this course will also have the opportunity to take part in talks by qualified coders and visit tech companies.

This course is a fantastic way for students to explore coding as a future career, whilst at the same time improving their English, having fun and exploring a new city.

ENGLISH FOR LEADERS

This course is ideal for entrepreneurs, business leaders, executives and politicians of the future. Students improve their English while learning how to deliver effective presentations, take the lead, inspire people and be aware of different cultures.
