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Personal Study Programme (PSP)

PSP can be combined with General English and forms a key part of the Academic and Business English courses.

PSP is ideal for fast improvement in the specific areas that students find difficult, enabling them to give attention to the skills and vocabulary of their choice

- Guided study with specially trained teachers
- Ratio of students to teachers typically 6:1
- 20 minutes of individual time with the teacher per week to practise speaking or writing
- Extensive audio-visual resources
- A daily journal kept with personalised messages to and from the teachers; a natural, authentic way to improve written communication
- Group activities, discussions and pronunciation activities to improve your speaking accuracy and fluency

Students may choose to focus on:

- Key skills (writing, grammar, etc.)

The International Civil Aviation Organisation (ICAO) requires that aviation industry personnel attain a standard of English at ICAO level 4 or above.

Our *ELPAC Aviation English* accredited classes will consolidate general English skills with a particular focus on improving listening and speaking ability in aviation industry contexts.

N.B. Students will also take the *ELPAC ICAO* accredited test.

- Communicating effectively in voice-only (telephone/radio-telephone) and in face-toface situations
- Communicating on work-related topics with accuracy and clarity
- Use of appropriate communicative strategies to exchange messages
- Recognising and resolving misunderstandings (e.g. checking, confirming, or clarifying information)
- Handling challenges presented by a complication or unexpected turn of events
- Using a dialect or accent which is intelligible to the aeronautical community





To enrol on a course

Adult students (16+) may start their course on any Monday (subject to avaliablility). Please book at least 1 week in advance to allow for the enrolments procedure. Students who require a visa will need to apply earlier.

Booking fees

Booking fees are non-refundable and cover student ID/access cards, course materials, enrolment, accommodation arrangements, and general and visa administration

Payment Procedure

All course and accommodation fees must be paid in full at the application stage. Confirmation documents will only be sent once payment is received.

Cancellation Policy

If the school is notified of cancellation 28 days or more before the course start date, full fees (excluding the administration, visa and courier fees, if applicable) will be refunded by *International House*. We strongly recommend that students take out appropriate insurance to cover fees and all costs in case of cancellation with less than 28 days' notice or in the event of leaving a course early. Student insurance policies will generally cover fees if a student has to go home early for a medical or other serious reason.

Course and accommodation changes made within 7 days of arrival will be charged one week's notice (course and accommodation).

Lessons

Each lesson (teaching hour) is 55 minutes long. Our class size is 12 students maximum (8 students average).

Timetable

Lessons are between 9am and 5pm, Monday to Friday. The timetable will depend on your level, the course and the number of hours you have booked. Typical timetables are: 09-11am and 1-3pm, or 11am to 1pm and 3-5pm. You may choose PSP for one or two lessons per day outside these times.

Junior Bookings

To comply with UK law, parents or guardians must complete an application, including the parental consent statement, in full to apply.

All under-18s must have two-way airport transfers booked through the school unless suitable alternative arrangements have been made and confirmed in writing. If you have arranged an Unaccompanied Minor Service with an airline, please consult the school 1 week prior to travel to confirm staff details.

Public Holidays

The school will close for UK public holidays (please note that no refund can be given for these days).

Accommodation

Accommodation bookings are from Sunday to Sunday, unless special arrangements are requested in advance. Arrival after 2pm and departure before 10am. Extra nights can be arranged but please confirm availability before booking your flight.

Visas

International House Newcastle holds a Student Sponsor Licence, and is permitted under UK Home Office rules to accept visa students for study. Please check your visa status when making an application, using the UK Home Office's webpage.

Visa students need to supply

- 1. Course application fully completed, including a UK address if accommodation has not been requested via the school.
- 2. Full payment of fees or proof of government sponsorship plus booking fee.
- 3. A copy of the passport.
